The Associate of Arts in Biological Sciences at Cleveland University-Kansas City (CUKC) offers accelerated pre-allied health sciences and general education coursework that can be completed in less than two years. The associate degree program requires a minimum of 60 credit hours of post-secondary coursework. Students are required to complete a minimum of 15 credit hours at CUKC.
