Federal Direct Loans

Must be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours per semester

Students enrolled in the MSHEP program will be:

- Automatically considered independent when completing the FAFSA
- Eligible to borrow up to **\$10,250** in Unsubsidized Direct Loans each semester
 - Direct Loans have a lifetime aggregate of \$138,500 (\$65,500 Subsidized)
 - This includes undergraduate Direct and Stafford Loans
 - Fixed interest rate is 5.28 %

Private Loans

These are private, credit-based loans and are not eligible to consolidate with federal loans. If approved, students may borrow up to the cost of attendance. More information on our website.
