Federal Direct Loans

Must be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours per trimester

Students enrolled in the Doctor of Chiropractic program will be:

- Automatically considered independent when completing the FAFSA
- Eligible to borrow up to **\$16,500** in Unsubsidized Direct Loans each trimester
 - Direct Loans have a lifetime aggregate of \$224,000 (\$65,500 Subsidized)
 - This includes undergraduate Direct and Stafford Loans
 - Fixed interest rate is 6.60 %

Federal Direct GradPLUS Loans

Must be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours per trimester

Students may apply for the Direct GradPLUS Loan after they have received their maximum loan eligibility under the Direct Loan Program as stated above

- Applicants must not have any adverse credit history
- The Direct GradPLUS Loan has federal benefits
 - No lifetime aggregate
 - May borrow up to the cost of attendance
 - Fixed interest rate is 7.60 %
 - Eligible for consolidation with other federal loans

Federal Work Study

This program provides jobs for students with financial need. Most positions are on campus and include teaching assistants, tutors and clerical jobs. Limited funding available.

Private Loans

These are private, credit-based loans and are not eligible to consolidate with federal loans. If approved, students may borrow up to the cost of attendance. More information on our website.
